ISSUE

EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE

River Bend CUSD #2 will hire, support and train motivated faculty who provide the best education possible to each student within a safe, supportive and welcoming setting.

MEASURE AND GOALS

- A. 100% of the students will demonstrate academic growth based on the New Illinois Learning Standards as measured by the PARCC exam by 2017.
- B. River Bend Students will reach 70% on college readiness and will maintain a graduation rate of 95%.
- C. Provide 40 hours of professional development to faculty on an annual basis.
- Incorporate 1:1 technology initiative by 2016 in grades K-12.
- Identify, develop and purchase curriculum that provides students with 21st century problem solving, team work, and technology skills.
- Increase the number of students reaching academic and behavioral RTI goals.
- G. Annually evaluate results from 5Essentials Survey to improve school and district climate.

ACTION PLANS

- A. Align curriculum to Il. Learning standards and develop a cohesive curriculum scope preK-12.
- B. FHS staff will develop and evaluate curriculum that supports college readiness standards.
- Work with district improvement team to annually plan and implement professional development goals.
- The technology committee will research, review and write a 1:1 technology plan incorporating grades preK-12.
- School improvement teams will annually review, identify, recommend and infuse 21st century skills into the curriculum.
- School improvement teams will annually review data on the number of students being served and the success of academic/ behavioral programming.
- Provide survey results to parents and community members.

FISCAL AND FACILITIES MANAGEMENT

River Bend CUSD #2 will maintain a healthy, equitable, continual plan for fiscal and facility management.

- A. Provide facilities that are accessible and safe to all stakeholders.
- Review and maintain a fiscally responsible budget given resources available.
- Identify facility improvements to enhance educational experiences.
