Approve Health Life Safety Amendment to purchase an air filtration system/welding booth at Fulton High School for the welding space in the amount of \$50,000 *The current filtration system is out dated and needs replaced. The architect is recommending a combination station/filtration system. HLS funds can be used for the purchase*
- H. Approve dual credit course online or on-site at Clinton Community College for Fulton High School Students *Mr. Hogue and Mr. Tennyson met with the administrative team from Clinton Community College and they are willing to offer dual credit courses for Fulton High School students for \$318.40 per credit*
- I. Approve construction of storm shelter for Pre-school *The architect has been out to see the location and is working with the company for final approval of the shelter*
- J. Approve Joint Agreement to participate in the Iowa Illinois School Food Cooperative *Approval of this agreement will allow River Bend to participate in the Iowa Illinois School Food Cooperative. The food co-op has approved adding River Bend to the current group of schools.*
- K. Approve request from Mr. Hogue to conduct a research case study involving the Community Involvement Program
- L. Authorize the sale of Bus #4, a 77 passenger 2003 Blue Bird School bus to Unity Christian School for \$2,000 at the end of the 2017-18 school year *Unity Christian School would like to purchase this bus and are willing to pay the same price that Central States Bus Sales was planning to pay for trade-in*
- M. Approve bid for lawn care *The bidding process will allow the district to receive competitive bids for lawn care*

Approve changing the May Board meeting date to May 29, 2018, and authorize Jane and Dan to pre-approve disbursement checks for regular scheduled date *8<sup>th</sup> Grade Promotion is scheduled for May 21, 2018, which would have been the next board meeting. Authorizing Jane and Dan to approve paying bills will allow disbursement checks to be mailed on the regular scheduled date of May 26, 2018*
