(includes coursework for CNA, CMA, LPN, RN, BSN, MSN, NP) All awards are for full- or part-time students, based on merit as well as financial need. Funds will be applied toward tuition and fees.

SCHOLARSHIP: Jill Adolph Nursing Scholarship

SPONSOR: Jeff Adolph, Jason Adolph Family and Justin Adolph Family AWARD: \$2,000 scholarship for one year

The Jill Adolph Nursing Scholarship was created in 2024 by her family in remembrance of her 36-year career in nursing at CGH Medical Center. She was a nurse and administrator at CGH clinics from 1986-2022, lastly as Director of Nursing, Physician Services. In all her roles, she embodied positivity, compassion and empathy. She was a true leader, role model and mentor, who pushed her staff, co-workers, and friends to be the best they could be. The family would like to encourage all levels of nursing students to apply, including CNA, CMA, LPN, RN, BSN, MSN and NP students.

SCHOLARSHIP: Edgar and Florence Hall Nursing Scholarship

AWARD: \$1,000 for one year

The Edgar and Florence Hall Nursing Scholarship was created in 2007 by their daughter, Maxine Hall, in their honor. Miss Hall was a long-time area teacher and supporter of continuing education.

The Althea Larson Nursing Scholarship was created in 2002 by the CGH Health Foundation to assist qualified individuals in pursuing a professional nursing career. It was renamed in 2012 to honor the late Mrs. Larson, who was a former CGH Board member and Foundation trustee. Scholars may receive up to four (4) annual scholarships.

AWARD: Two \$1,000 scholarships for one year

The new Anne C. Marry Nursing Scholarship was created in 2024 by her daughter, Kathy Shirley, and husband, Glenn. Mrs. Marry retired as the director of the pediatrics unit at St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee, where she worked for most of her career. She developed lifelong connections with her fellow nurses, who even in her 92nd year she still sees regularly. Her legacy extends through the "hard work" ethic she taught generations of her family and the countless staff and parents she supported and mentored. Her family is proud to offer this grant in testament to her commitment to the nursing profession.

SCHOLARSHIP: CGH Medical Center Auxiliary Healthcare Scholarship

AWARD: Up to five \$1,000 scholarships for one year
