- 4. Student must have an accumulative grade point average of 3.3 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- 5. Student must have exemplary conduct and citizenship.
- 6. Student must have had outstanding participation in school activities.

The scholarship shall be awarded in the spring of the year at the Fulton High School Awards Night.

The scholarship payment shall be made directly to the institution of higher learning that the recipient is planning to attend.

(In the event the recipient fails to enroll as a full-time student, or the recipient fails to declare a major in an education-related field, the scholarship shall become null and void and shall not be distributed by the River Bend Educational Foundation.)
