12 <u>FAFSA - THE FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID</u> is now a <u>required step for students to earn a diploma</u> from an Illinois High School. For more information, go to the Financial Aid/FAFSA tab under FHS Counselor's Corner on the district website. Students and parents can get started by creating an FSA ID by going to https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch. This year's FAFSA application opened December 1. IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT YOU GO CREATE YOUR FSA ID NOW. THERE IS A WAITING PERIOD BETWEEN WHEN YOU CREATE YOUR ID TO WHEN YOU CAN COMPLETE THE APPLICATION.

11-12 <u>AP STUDENTS THAT SIGNED UP TO TAKE THE AP EXAM MUST PAY THEIR EXAM FEE BY MARCH 21ST</u> The cost is \$99 or \$20 for students who qualify for free/reduced lunch. If you signed up for the exam and decide you no longer want to take the exam you will be responsible for the \$40 cancellation fee.

9-11 ACT PREP April 10th is all school test day. This means grades 9 and 10 will be taking the Pre-ACT and grade 11 will be taking the ACT. The time to start preparing is now! Make a student account on myact.org to gain access to practice questions in all subject areas, a practice question of the day, online practice exams, and all of the other resources ACT has to offer. You will also be able to view test results here at a later date. The ACT is important for college applications and is a reflection of our school- you must be as prepared as possible for test day!

9-11 <u>REGISTRATION FOR NEXT YEAR</u> is starting up soon. Students need to start planning for next year's courses. Remember, required classes that are not passed 1st and/or 2nd semester will have to be taken again next year. Talk to your teachers about class options and prerequisites.

The Creating Entrepreneurial Opportunities (CEO)Class Advisory Board welcomes your application to participate in the 2025-2026 CEO Class. This course is supported by the business community in the Sauk Valley region in partnership with the member schools of the Whiteside Area Career Center (WACC) The class meets at a variety of businesses in the region and is facilitated by LeAndra Hartman in collaboration with our business partners. 11-12 ARE YOU AN 18 YEARS OLD MALE? If you are, you are required by law to register with selective service. You can register as early as 17 years and 3 months old. By doing so you will be eligible for student loans and grants, job training, and government jobs. Failing to register can lead to a 5-year prison sentence and up to \$250,000 fine.
